Frame and Pattern

Additional Products: green cardstock, natural corrugated cardboard, Onyx Black Versafine ink, Wedding Dress Memento Luxe ink, Winsor & Newton masking fluid, Faber Castell Albrecht Durer watercolor pencils, Signo white gel pen, Sharpie ultrafine markers, polka dot grosgrain ribbon, white gesso, clear Wink of Stella pen

Instructions:

- 1. Splatter masking fluid on six 1.5" white tiles.
- 2. Place tiles edge to edge in a 2x3 array on masking paper or post-it notes to hold them together while stamping and coloring.
- 3. With Onyx Black Versafine ink stamp village stamp from transparent set "Gleeful" on array of tiles.
- 4. Using a waterbrush pick up blue pigment from a watercolor pencil and paint the sky.
- 5. Using a selection of watercolor pencils color and blend the buildings and trees in the stamped image.
- 6. When watercoloring is dry rub off all masking fluid to reveal 'falling snow'
- 7. Using ultrafine Sharpie markers and a clear Wink of Stella pen add highlights to design
- 8. Using a white gel pen draw snow on roofs, window trim and around doorways.
- 9. To assemble hanging decoration, cut a corrugated cardboard base using 'Frame' die. Paint white gesso around border. Cut green cardstock rectangle and wipe Memento Luxe Wedding Dress ink around border.
- 10. Remove Art Square tiles from masking paper and attach to dark green mat leaving a small margin between tiles. Attach matted tile panel to corrugated cardboard and punch two holes at top for polka dot ribbon.
