Black Ink; Lead Pencil; Inktense
Pencils: Poppy Red (0400), Chinese
Ink (2030), Payne's Grey (2110);
Copic Multi-Liner 0.1; Double-Sided
Tape, Kids Funky Foam White;
Watercolor Paper; Grey Cardstock

Instructions:

Cut a panel out of watercolor paper measuring 16 x 16 cm and tape it down to your craft surface with masking tape. Sketch a scene with your pencil. Stamp the girls and the streetlight from the On the Town set with black pigment ink onto your scene. Add color/shading with inktense pencils and blend them with water. After your coloring is totally dry, add details with Copic Multi-liner. Stamp the sentiment from Beauty of the Season set with black pigment ink on the lower right corner of your panel. Carefully remove the masking tape and mount your watercolor panel onto a light grey panel (measuring 16.4 x 16.4cm). Cut a square measuring 18.5 x 18.5cm out of darker grey card stock and adhere your art piece to it.
