Penny Black Products Used: 30-331 Critter Love, 30-297 Sprinkles and Smiles

Additional Products: Watercolor paper

Distress inks - Broken China, Stormy Sky and Black Soot, Spun Sugar, Pumice Stone

Black Archival Ink

Papericious two way sticker sheet

Glitters

Instructions:

The background is created using Broken China, Stormy Sky and Black Soot Distress Inks on watercolor paper.

Rajni sprinkled little water, dabbed it with tissue paper and heat set it. The background and the large stars are hand cut using handmade template. A few stars are punched from regular card stock. Then, she transferred the stars on two way Papericious stickersheet, removed the sticker paper and sprinkled glitter on it, dusting the extras.

The main focal image is from 30-331 Critter Love. Rajni stamped the image twice and neatly fussy-cut both of them.

She then discarded the moon from one image and painted it with Spun Sugar and Pumice Stone distress inks. Now, on the second image, Rajni transferred two way sticker sheet on the stamped moon (don't worry if it covers more as it is going to hide under the top painted image anyway) and sprinkled golden glitter, dusting the extras. Adhere both with glue dots keeping the glittered moon image in the bottom.

The sentiment is from 30-297 Sprinkles and Smiles and is stamped using black archival ink.
