Additional Products: Distress Ink Pads: Forest Moss and Peeled Paint; Distress stains: Tarnished Brass, Stormy Sky, Shaded Lilac, Picket Fence, Chipped Sapphire, Fired Brick, Spiced Marmalade; VersaFine Onyx Black Ink; White Embossing Powder; Stickles Star Dust; Fabriano watercolor cardstock, 100% cotton, 140 lbs hot pressed

Instructions:

- 1- Ink Let's Chill with Onyx Black ink and stamp. Make a mask and hide the little girl.
- 2- Use Forest Moss to ink the tree from Woodland Beauty and use MISTI to stamp a little behind the girl.
- 3- Use Forest Moss, Peeled Paint, and Onyx Black to ink Tranquil and stamp.
- 4- Trace a horizon line and start coloring with a mixture of Stormy Sky, Chipped Sapphire, and add Picket Fence which will give a hazy effect. Let dry.
- 5- Start coloring the sky with Tarnished Brass on each side and use the colors in no.4 above, highly diluted, for the rest of the sky.
- 6- Add white embossing powder here and there on the trees and emboss. Heat the underside of the cardstock so the powder won't fly away with the blow of the heat tool. Add some large grains on the sky and emboss.
- 7- Use Fired Brick and Spiced Marmalade for the little girl's hat and scarf (nice orangy-red) and Shaded Lilac and Chipped Sapphire for the coat.
- 8- Diluted Chipped Sapphire was used to create the shadows on the snow.
- 9- Add Stickles Star Dust on the snow and stamp the sentiment.
